

Check their capabilities and see if they align with your needs. Confirm they have experience with your product type. Get a sense of their communication style and responsiveness.



# **REQUEST QUOTATIONS:**

Provide them with detailed product and packaging specifications. Include forecasted volumes and production schedules.



# **VISIT THEIR FACILITY:**

Assess cleanliness and organization. Verify they meet industry standards and certifications. Evaluate their equipment's capacity and compatibility with your product.



### **CHECK REFERENCES:**

Contact current or past clients. Ask about their experiences, reliability, quality control, and problem-solving abilities

# EVALUATE FINANCIAL STABILITY:

A stable copacker is less likely to run into production issues or go out of business. You can use tools like Dun & Bradstreet or financial statements to assess their financial health.





Discuss pricing, payment terms, minimum order quantities, and lead times. Understand penalties, if any, for changes in production schedules.



# **REVIEW CONTRACTS THOROUGHLY:**

Ensure the contract outlines all terms clearly, including confidentiality clauses and intellectual property protection. It's advisable to consult with a lawyer specializing in contract or business law.



## **START WITH A TRIAL RUN:**

Before committing to large volumes, do a test run to assess quality and consistency. Use this opportunity to provide feedback and make any necessary adjustments.





# MONITOR AND EVALUATE PERFORMANCE:
